

Whether it is a simple change in size or color, or a more detailed change such as modifying an existing trim, duplicating an antique trim or creating a new trim from a new design; Samuel & Sons Custom Program can make the process much easier than you may have anticipated. We can produce anything from the most subtle color modification to the most avant-garde detailing. Whatever your design vision is, we can make it a reality.

Designers frequently use our custom products for residential, hospitality and historical installations. Our work includes pieces for theater and museum restorations as well as new items for national institutions such as the Clinton Presidential Library and the White House.

crystal tassel is a shorter version of our 12* double crystal tassel tieback, which we milled in a custom colorway to match the client's specifications. Two tassels were produced in six weeks after the client's approval of the yarns.

HOW THE CUSTOM PROGRAM WORKS


The following details outline how our Custom Program works:

Minimum Yardage

Our average minimum typically varies from 11 to 20 yards, or 2-6 pieces. On occasion, we are able to create even smaller quantities, and larger minimums may apply to a select few.

Quantity Pricing

Yardage plays a big part in the pricing of custom trim. A larger quantity can more evenly distribute the setup expenses (the most costly part of custom production), resulting in a lower unit cost.

trim a fresh look in earthy tones. The client required 36 yards and delivery was less than six weeks, an impressive timeframe for this rosette border.



Normal Lead Time

Our average estimated lead time is 4-8 weeks once threads are approved. Threads for approval typically add two weeks and occur prior to production.

Accelerated Lead Time

There are ways to get a custom request completed within 2-3 weeks. However, it will depend on the factors below:

- Threads for approval usually take about two weeks. If you are comfortable with eliminating this step, you have already saved that time.
- For antique or new design trims, our mills
 first examine the construction before they
 begin setup and production. If one mill is
 unable to produce the trim, we will confer
 with another mill. This process can take time.
 Choosing to customize a trim from our
 existing line may eliminate that delay. Certain
 trims from our collection have faster lead
 times than others—please discuss your project
 with a sales associate for more information.

Many designers consider specifying a custom-made trim to be a difficult prospect, but it doesn't have to be.

Quotations

In order to supply a quotation on a Custom Program order, the following information is required:

- 1. What is the trim design?
- 2. How much yardage is needed?
- 3. What is the fiber content required?
- Deposit Payments

We request a 50% deposit to initiate the order.

Color Threads for Approval

You have the option to get threads for approval to confirm the color you requested. This usually takes about two weeks.


Production


